Ried Kirchenberg Grüner Veltliner Herzstück 2020

The sheltered, south-east facing vineyard situated below the historic church of Senftenberg, rests on a bedrock of mica schist. The protected location and the soil give the Grüner Veltliner planted here its typical gooseberry-quince aroma and the abundance of minerals as is hardly possible in any other location.

Tasting Note:

Tobacco spiciness, ripe Apfel fruit, tropical hints, juicy, powerful and beautiful minerality.
